## FITASC Sporting Winter Rules as agreed by the BICTSF board 5th March 2022

FITASC Paris Have very kindly sanctioned the BICTSF to allow the use of 5 x 20 target competitions during GMT only, however, they have also authorised the BICTSF to allow the use of this format during BST as long as there is a genuine reason for its requirement and prior approval must be sanctioned by the BICTSF before an event can commence.

Covering the period, when the clocks change in October from British Summer Time (BST) to Standard Time (GMT) until the clocks return to BST in March.

Grounds can run their shoots by using either the International FITASC Sporting Rules 4 x 25 target layouts consisting of 60 singles and 20 doubles per 100 targets (15 singles & 5 doubles per layout) or a new winter format consisting of 5 x 20 target layouts.

The winter format would consist of 5 layouts each containing 12 singles and 4 doubles being shot from 3 positions around 4 traps, 2 positions would throw 4 singles and 1 double with the other position throwing 4 singles and 2 doubles.

There should be **no** variation to the formats outlined above.
