



FITASC SPORTING BRITISH MASTERS CHAMPIONSHIP IAN COLEY'S SHOOTING SCHOOL FRIDAY, 20TH & SATURDAY, 21ST MARCH 2026

IMPORTANT SHOOT INFORMATION

1. TIES:

Due to time restraints at the ground the BICTSF have decided to resolve a tie for category medals by way of countback.

Shooter score countback process for FITASC Sporting will be applied as follows:- the total score from layout 6, then 5, then 4, then 3, then 2, then 1, if the scores are still unresolved then the countback will be by target from layout 6 starting at target 25, then, 24, then 23 and so on until a '0' (zero/lost target) is on the card, the first shooter with a '0' (zero/lost target) is out.

Cash prizes are always resolved by countback.

2. COLTS:

A Colt (aged under 17) on the last day of the shoot will have their score calculated in both the Colts and Juniors categories, and will take the higher medal position i.e. Should they win in Colts a Gold medal, and also win in Juniors a Bronze medal, they will be awarded the Bronze medal in Juniors as the Bronze medal is the higher status medal category.

3. MEMBERSHIP:

You must be a 2026 paid up BICTSF member (active membership) for your scores to be included in the BICTSF rankings for GB Team selection, in accordance with GB Team selection criteria.

4. AIMPOINT PRODUCTS:

Please be aware that FITASC sporting disciplines do not allow artificial aiming devices, therefore, anyone using an Aimpoint product will not be eligible to win any Trophies, Medals or Cash Prizes and will also be excluded from the selection process for GB Team places.
